Thanks to those of you who participate in the online NTC Kennel and Stud Listings. In addition to being a useful tool for those looking for a Norfolk Terrier, it is also a source of income for the Club.

Summary: Many of the calls received were from former Norfolk or other terrier owners that had to put down their beloved dogs. Most of the Norfolk that they put down died from Mitral Valve per the owners. Others died from complication of the heart meds for Mitral Valve. No one mentioned any death from cancer. I also had some other breeders contact me to let me know that they had older pups or dogs available approximate ages 9 months to 4 years and I do get calls for older dogs but not over the age of 5. I am not getting many calls from breeders telling me that they have had a litter or any pups available and I think the callers are also emailing the breeders that are listed on our website directly and emailing me at the same time. Many of them have already spoken to some of the breeders when I talk to them and think that I may have another list of folks which is not the case.

I mentioned last year that we need to cross post the Norwich Grooming article that is on their website and put on ours, as folks do not realize what happens to their coats and that without regular grooming they become one big mop and they can get matted. It has been a challenge to locate folks to hand strip in some locations. It might also be good to put on our website a list of folks in various states who do hand stripping and the breeds they can do.

For those that do call me, please let me know when the puppies and or dogs are no longer available so I don't keep referring folks to you. It would also be nice if I knew if you placed a puppy with someone who had contacted me. I do not have any stats for that.

Contemporary social media has had a tremendous impact on the world as we know it. The media 'du jour' may change but there is nothing that would indicate that impact will be diminished or the computing public that has grown more accustomed, even addicted to it, will withdraw attention from it. Our group Facebook page The Norfolk Terrier Club USA was established in 2009 and currently enjoys the interest and active participation of 750 members.

The Norfolk group page is a kinetic, inclusive vehicle of breed information, breaking news, introduced and rehashed issues and concerns, photographs, and commentary. The group has proven to be a significant repository of all things associated with our breed. Interested people can request membership by simply applying via comment on the group page and after a quick vetting process, will be assimilated into the ranks of Norfolk 'groupies.'

As administrator, I monitor the page daily, systematically weeding out folks that seek to advertise breed centric wares or services and those that seek to defame or focus negative comments toward members or the breed itself. I add articles and information I find and people send to me, that might be of interest to this group. The page serves as the official Facebook venue for Club members, prospective members and fanciers of Norfolk Terriers. In our introductory comments, we indicate that the site is available for espousing all positive aspects of our breed and the viewers are reminded that within this group there is no place for vitriol, destructive innuendo or any form of negative comment. The page is modestly successful, with 700 plus members and daily readership of upwards of 450 is not insubstantial. I haven't expunged more than 10 people since the group was organized.

Our Facebook Group page can be used to impart timely news and information to members and provide insight to fanciers who are not members, about actions and activities are being held for the benefit of members of the Norfolk Terrier Club here in the United States. Exposure and information can garner an ever broadening membership base.

I am hopeful that this social medium portal will continue growing and will become more extensively used by the Club officers and members announcing activities and promulgating items that are of interest and importance to Breed club members and fanciers alike. Communication assures organizational strength and cultivates unity.

HEALTH

Marian Shaw, DVM & Jim Sternberg, DVM

During this year the results of the DNA testing for Mitral Valve Disease were made available from Dr. Oyama at the University of Pennsylvania. 100 DNA samples were tested, 50 normal dogs, defined as no heart murmur or abnormal echocardiogram results after the age of 4 years and 50 abnormal dogs defined as having a murmur and an abnormal echocardiogram at any age. No distinct genetic differences were found, but these samples will be stored to be tested in an all breed study looking for mitral valve disease markers. Mitral valve disease is the most common cardiac problem in dogs and is primarily seen in small breed dogs. It is believed that the genetic basis may be found by looking at a larger sample population. These results do support our experience as breeders that it is not a simple single gene problem. We still recommend testing all of our dogs to continue to improve our selection of breeding stock.

During the year we also discussed with the membership the presence of a new respiratory disease agent, Influenza H3N2 which was believed to originate in swine and was brought to the US with rescue dogs from Asia. Common sense rules apply, isolate sick dogs for 4 weeks. Minimize contact with other dogs and disinfect crates, water dishes used in public areas. Vaccination was also discussed and protocols and types were deferred to a conversation with you and your regular veterinarian.

During the upcoming year we would like to educate our membership on the new and rapidly developing field of DNA testing and discuss which tests/diseases might be applicable to our breeds.

As always we welcome input from our membership of any health concerns in our breed that they would like to study or have a speaker at one of our club meetings.

Norfolk Terrier Rescue (“Rescue”), a non-profit (501(c)(3)) organization associated with NTC, has experienced a busy year. We have been able to find forever homes for ten Norfolk Terriers. As of September 6, 2017 we have \$7000 in our Rescue Treasury. Before placing a Norfolk, we spay/neuter, microchip, have a medical check and dental completed. We have also given scholarships for training for our placements. We would like to thank the many members who remember us with their generous donations. Without them we could not do this good work. On a monthly basis, we maintained a spreadsheet of AKC titles earned by Norfolk Terriers. In 2016 there were 164 titles earned in 7 areas: Conformation, Agility, Barn Hunt, Canine Good Citizen, Coursing Ability, Earthdog, and Rally. The largest group was Conformation with 49 new Champions and 17 Grand Champions, followed closely by 47 Agility titles earned. Coursing Ability was third with 21 titles earned.

In addition, we produced a year-end report of the Partree and Maplehurst Cup winners, the Top Ten All-Breed and Bread Point earners as well as the Top Sires and Top Dams. In 2016, we had two Partree Cup winners after a 2015 with neither a Maplehurst Cup nor Partree Cup award winner.

We have implemented the Members Only page with a User ID and Password requirement to access. We are also working to address specific access issues from unauthorized access. I believe it resides in the placement of files on the web server. I am working with the Web Hosting service to isolate and correct the issue.

Behind this portal, we have the On-Line Pedigree database, the Norfolk Notes Archive, and the NTC Directory. We have implemented a search engine capability for the Awards/Titles to reduce the number of pages and ease of updating. The NTC Photo Gallery is a problem to update due to the time required for the manipulation of photos, I am working on options for a solution.

I am transitioning the Webmaster duties to the New Webmaster, Terri Smith. This is being accomplished while still maintaining the current website with all the related materials and updates as required.

We have 1798 titles available on the web site dating back to February 2004. Files are received by Andrew Kramer from the AKC. He forwards those files monthly (usually 6-8 weeks after the month of award).

We have over 27,000 Norfolk Terrier entries in the Pedigree Database that Andrew Kramer maintains and provides for upload to the web site.

I recommend that the Board consider a Database Administrator to centralize the information at one source of entry and exit for the wide range of NTC needs to include membership information, label production, titles, awards, dues, and correspondence.

I will continue to serve at the pleasure of the NTC President and the NTC Board.
