Safety Briefing

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. *Every dog must check in and pass inspection before each run.* The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. At check in, dogs will be inspected for disqualification; dogs may be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps. Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused. *Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.*

Entry Process and Fees

\$25.00 per entry per dog per test
(Includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

Closing date is September 21, 2024 at 6:00 PM, no cancellations refunded after the closing date. All cancellations are subject to \$3.00 processing fee per entry. Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be accepted. **Entries are accepted ONLY online at www.sugarloafmountainracing.com** and will have an additional \$0.50 processing fee added per entry. NO PAPER ENTRIES will be accepted. Entries received by phone, text, or email will not be accepted. Incomplete entries or forms without signature will not be accepted. Please follow the instructions on www.sugarloafmountainracing.com.

***If space available after closing, entries can be made up until 8 PM the night before online at www.sugarloafmountainracing.com; late entries will be \$30 per entry per dog.**

Conditions of Entry

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Dogs may only run once per test.

All participants are required to comply with any and all state, local or facility COVID-19 requirements in effect during this event. Any deviation or refusal to cooperate with The Norfolk Terrier Club or In The Net regarding health and safety rules will result in a bench hearing and immediate dismissal with no refunds.

Please note that the Club table is off limits to everyone except the person picking up awards. You may leave all your dog's awards and pick them up on the last day you are entered. We ask that you run your dog with a small break between runs if entered twice, and promptly leave the Fast CAT site.

Trial Hours

Entries will be limited to 80 dogs per event, two events daily running concurrently, Tuesday and Wednesday, October 1 and October 2, 2004, from 9:00 AM until 2:00 PM or all runs are completed. Grounds will be available no earlier than one hour prior to trial hours.

Ribbons and Prizes

The Norfolk Terrier Club will offer a light blue flat ribbon for a passing qualifying run and will have a limited number of title rosettes available. Those earning FCAT2-5 have the option of an FCAT title rosette OR a Golden Bunny trophy; those earning FCAT6 and above, have the option of an FCAT title rosette, OR a Golden Bunny trophy OR an embroidered cooler bag. Trial Site Directions

From the North

(Northern New Jersey/New York/Wilkes Barre/Scranton)

Interstate 78 West to Interstate 81 South to Exit 29a Route 934 South to Route 322 West to Route 117 North.

Turn right on Airport Road.

From the South

(Baltimore/York)

Interstate 83 North to Route 322 At Harrisburg to Route 322 East to Route 117 North.

Turn right on Airport Road.

From the East(Southern New Jersey/Philadelphia/Reading)

Pennsylvania Turnpike (Interstate 76) West to Exit 266 to Route 72 North to Route 322 West to Route 117 North.

(Ohio/Pittsburgh/Carlisle)

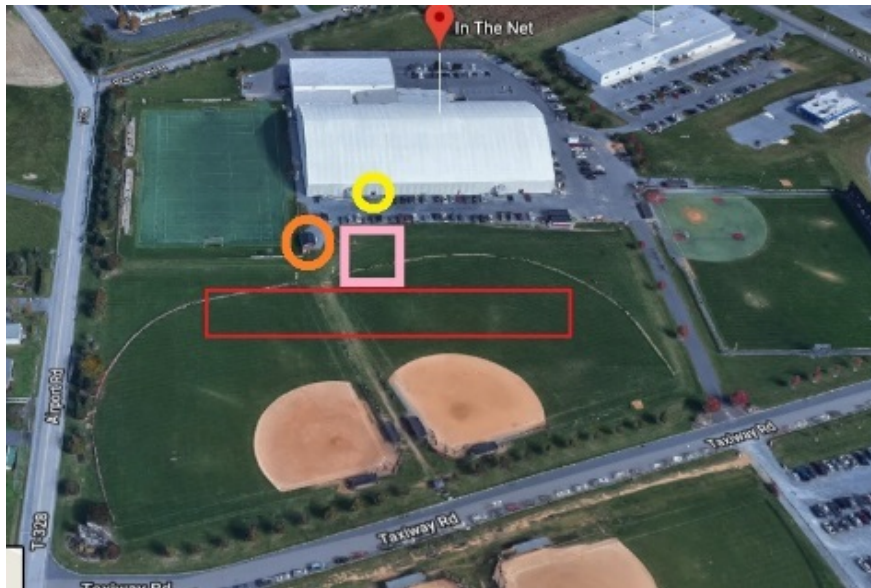
Pennsylvania Turnpike (Interstate 76) East to Exit 266 to Route 322 East to Route 117 North.

Notice To All Exhibitors

All exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel, RV and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels, RV sites or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same. All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds and RV sites are considered within the trial grounds. You are responsible for all damage to your room/site and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Event Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel or RV facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

Course Map



Red box is approximately the length of the entire course. Dogs will run 100 yards with 40-yard finish area past the finish line. Course will be fenced in. Yellow circle is the exit door from the main building. Pink box and orange circle will be the check-in areas. No parking permitted on the grass anywhere on the property or in the RV lot. Please park in the parking lots and do not block RV access. There will be a marked area for entry to the field through the parked RVs. Use ONLY that walk-through area.

FUN RUN!!!

The Norfolk Terrier Club will hold a "Fun Run" for new dogs and puppies on Tuesday, October 1, 2024, 30 minutes after the last official run. The cost is \$10 for two (2) runs per dog and payable in cash. There will be a sign up sheet on site at the registration desk and dogs will run in the order signed up.

General Trial Information

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- An electronic timing system will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced.
- On site bathrooms are available.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/NTC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of In the Net.
- The Norfolk Terrier Club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.

What is Fast CAT?

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100 yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100 yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)}$

Based on the dog' size at the withers, a handicap is applied and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS}$

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog' name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points
